SERMON

PROFESSION OF FAITH (8:15 & 10:30)

P: Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God? C: I renounce them.

P: Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God? C: I renounce them.

P: Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God? C: I renounce them.

P: Do you believe in God the Father?

C: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

C: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven. He is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

P: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

C: I believe in the Holy Spirit,

the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

Each student kneels for the reading of his/her Bible verse, then follows the laying-on-of-hands and prayer:

P: Father in heaven, for Jesus' sake, stir up in ______ the gift of your Holy Spirit; confirm their faith, guide their life. Empower them in their serving. Give them patience in suffering, and bring them to everlasting life.

After all are confirmed, the pastors address parents, sponsors, and the congregation.

- C: We do, and we ask God to help and guide us.
- P: Let us rejoice with these sisters and brothers in Christ.
- C: We rejoice with you as the Lord's family. We celebrate your confirmation as fellow members of the body of Christ, children of the same Heavenly Father, and workers with us in the kingdom of God.
